WORSHIP NOTES

Today is the second Sunday after the Epiphany. We hear John 1:29-42: *Revelation of Christ as the Lamb of God.*

ANNUAL MEETING

The annual meeting of the congregation will take place in the Parish Hall on Sunday, January 29, 2017, following the 10:45 am worship service. A luncheon precedes the meeting. Documents relative to the meeting are available in the lower narthex. Please write your name on the back of your weekly attendance card or call the church office during the week to sign up for the luncheon.

STEAM PIPE REPAIR

A steam pipe located under the floor in the lower narthex by the restrooms will be repaired beginning this week. This area will be off limits until the necessary repairs are completed.

ORGAN COMMITTEE

Central in worship, the present pipe organ at Christ Lutheran Church is now almost 50 years old. Due to its age, it is in a state of rapid deterioration.

Representatives of the Peragallo family and Organ Company will share some of the interesting aspects of their rebuilding process and answer your questions today between services. They will also be available after the late service. The discussion will take place in the nave.

The restoration and rebuilding plan includes:

- * Preservation of pipe work
- * Upgrading of mechanical components with new, efficient parts
- * A redesign of the organ chambers and repurposing of the pipes of the *Ruckpositiv* division from the balcony,
- * use of the front left organ chamber (directly above the sacristy)
- * a new four manual console, with new and efficient technology

Several pipes have been removed to demonstrate the number of non-speaking pipes located in the case-work. These pipes are one element in the motivation to redesign the case-work and organ chambers (that which houses the organ pipes).
