### WORSHIP NOTES

Today is Palm Sunday/Sunday of the Passion. Since at least the fourth century and universally in the church since the eighth, Christians have kept the Sunday before Easter as a memorial of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, and a literal procession of palms, started in Jerusalem, has spread throughout the world. This service has a two-part focus: Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, and his passion and death.

Our service starts in the courtyard with a procession of palms, followed by a dramatic and responsorial reading of the Passion of Our Lord according to Matthew.
